## Toxic Substances Control Act (TSCA)

### Re: TSCA Regulated Substances in Articles

Iridium Satellite LLC (Iridium) is committed to providing our customers with safe and environmentally friendly products. We take pride in our environmental compliance leadership and are committed to minimizing the impact of our operations on the environment.

The Toxic Substances Control Act (TSCA), as amended by the Frank R. Lautenberg Chemical Safety for the 21st Century Act, sets a mandatory requirement for the EPA to evaluate existing chemicals with clear and enforceable deadlines along with the duty to evaluate chemicals and perform risk-based chemical assessments. This includes, among other mandates, assessing and managing chemicals under TSCA for persistent, bioaccumulative, and toxic (PBT) chemicals under TSCA section 6(h) per 40 CFR 751, as well as the requirements laid out in TSCA Section 5(a)(2) as it pertains to certain LC-PFAC chemical substances used as part of a surface coating per 40 CFR 721.10536.

Iridium has reviewed, as of April 2021, its transceiver products for the presence of the five (5) PBT substances recently subjected to new use restrictions under TSCA.

Iridium has also reviewed its transceiver products for the presence of LC-PFACs chemical substances as part of a surface coating as of November 2021.

None of the above TSCA substances subject to the listed requirements were found to be present in any of Iridium's products. This determination is based on a risk-based assessment which includes engineering evaluation and testing of high-risk components and is correct to the best of Iridium's knowledge.
