

## Configuring Firefox for Iridium Accesspoint (PC & Mac)

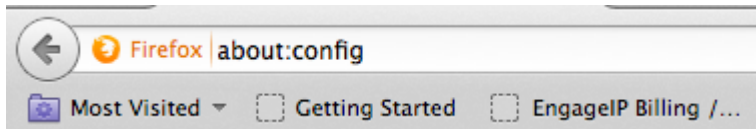
To browse the web with the Accesspoint you will need to use the Firefox browser. The Firefox browser can be downloaded from [getfirefox.com](http://getfirefox.com).

You will also need to register for an Iridium mail & web account: <https://www.iridium.com/Iridium-Mail-and-Web-Registration.aspx>

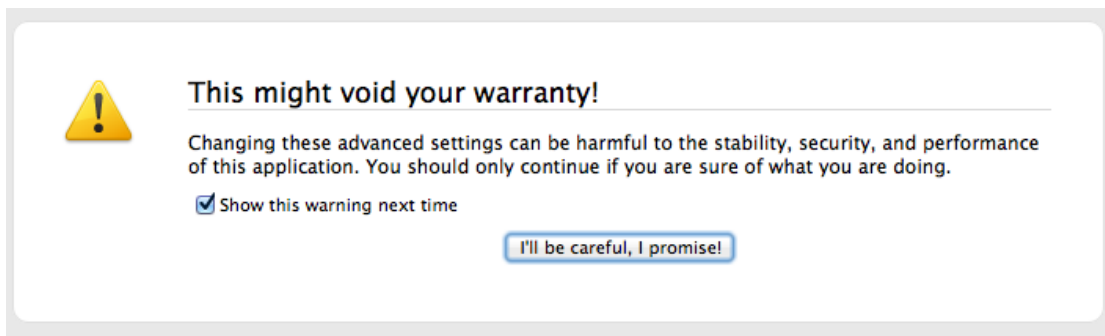
NOTE: The screenshots for this article were taken from a Mac, but the instructions are also valid for Windows based PCs as well.

Once the browser has been downloaded and installed, follow these steps:

1. Open Firefox
2. In the address bar type in about:config and then hit the enter key



3. A warning will appear in your browser window, click on "I'll be careful, I promise"

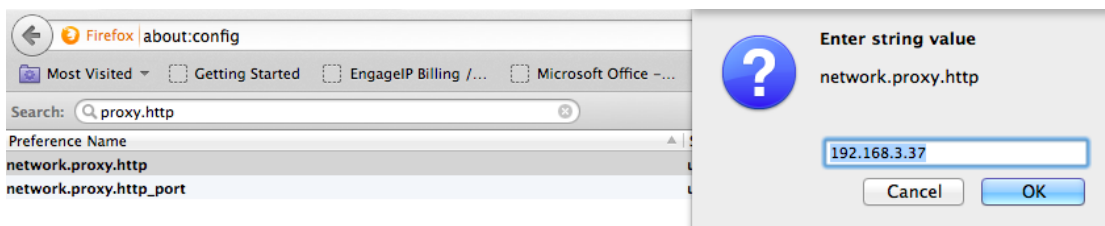


4. In the search bar type in proxy.http

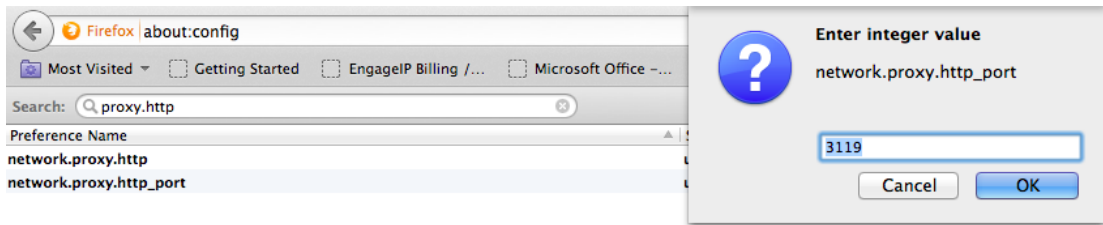


5. Two results will appear: network.proxy.http and network.proxy.http\_port

6. Double click on network.proxy.http, type in 192.168.3.37 and then click on "OK"



7. Double click on network.proxy.http\_port, type in 3119 and then click on "OK"



8. Exit the browser

9. Open the Accesspoint software to create a web connection

10. When you navigate to a website for the first time, you will be asked to authenticate. Use your Iridium Mail and Web username and password
